This award is a non-renewable scholarship presented to an outstanding **sophomore** student (defined as **30-59 completed credit hours at the end of spring 2019**) enrolled at the Newark Campus. Interested students must complete the application form and submit a **typed** essay addressing the question: **“What does leadership mean to me and why is it important?”**

To be considered, interested students must:

- Complete the William Allen Kilpatrick Scholarship Application by **March 1, 2019**.
- Have completed between 30 - 59 credit hours at the end of **spring 2019**.
- Have been enrolled at least 10 credit hours during the majority of terms enrolled.
- Have a cumulative GPA of at least 3.0 or higher.
- Be an active member in one or more Newark Campus student organizations or other worthwhile student activities.
- Submit a typed essay addressing the question: **“What does Leadership mean to me and why is it important?”**
