The following scholarship applications are available in the **Scholarship Central Resource Room** at the Muskingum County Community Foundation:

**Ohio Township Association Scholarships**

Deadline is **January 29, 2010**. The OTA offers three \$1,500 scholarships for 2010. Student must reside in one of the 1,308 townships in Ohio. Applicants must submit: completed application; a 500-word essay; high school transcript; and two letters of recommendation. Finalists will be notified by March 30 and asked to participate in an interview. Finalists will be notified by March 30 and asked to take part in an interview. Scholarship winners will be notified by May 3.

**The Sam Walton Community Scholarship**

Applications must be **submitted online by 5:00 p.m., central time, January 29, 2010**. A \$3,000 college scholarship available to graduating seniors with at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA and a demonstrated financial need.

**The Wal-Mart Associate Scholarship**

Applications must be **submitted online by 5:00 p.m., central time, January 29, 2010**. A \$3,000 college scholarship available to Walmart associates or dependents of associates who are graduating seniors with at least a 2.5 cumulative GPA and a demonstrated financial need.

**The Wal-Mart Higher Reach Scholarship**

Applications must be **submitted online by 5:00 p.m., central time, January 29, 2010**. Provides a college scholarship up to \$3,000 to Walmart associates who have been out of school for at least one year.

### **Walton Family Foundation Scholarship**

Applications must be **submitted online by 5:00 p.m., central time, January 29, 2010.**

Administered by the Walmart Foundation, the Walton Family Foundation Scholarship is a \$13,000 scholarship paid out over four years. Applicants must be dependents of Walmart associates, have at least a 22 ACT or 1030 SAT (Critical Reading + Math) score and prove financial need.

### **The Susan Writing Award**

Deadline is by the **end of the business day on February 8, 2010.** Up to five \$1,000 awards to local students for creative writing. For seniors attending East Muskingum, Franklin, Maysville, Morgan, Ridgewood, River View, Tri-Valley or West Muskingum Local Schools. Submit samples of writing.

### **John H. McConnell Scholarship**

Deadline is **March 1, 2010 (in office) by noon.** Intended to reward local high school seniors who demonstrate hard work, perseverance, leadership and community involvement. The scholarship winners will be selected annually by the Foundation's Board of Directors and announced in the spring at the end of each Blue Jackets season.

### **2010 Bar G Oil and Gas Scholarship**

All application materials must be **postmarked by March 15th, 2010.** A \$1,000 scholarship will be awarded in 2010 to a graduating senior from the Mid-East Technology Center in Zanesville to pursue higher-education opportunities. Applicants must be a resident of Muskingum County, planning to attend Zane State College starting fall term of 2010 and have a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a 4.0 scale).

### **Carolyn Ann Weiner Scholarship**

Deadline is **March 15, 2010.** Two \$500 awards to college-bound high school seniors in Muskingum, Guernsey, and Morgan Counties. Nominations by guidance counselors, ministers, principals or physicians are reviewed on the student's character and ability to succeed in spite of extraordinary challenges. One winner from Rosecrans and one selected other area high school.

### **Leasure Family Scholarship**

Deadline is **March 15th, 2010.** Scholarship awards for teachers who teach and/or live in Muskingum County. Teachers must currently be enrolled in a graduate program (having completed six quarter or four semester hours) at an accredited institution of higher education (full or part time). Consideration given to essay, recommendations, grades, and community involvement. Teachers whose employers reimburse their tuition are ineligible.

### **Rich Greiner Scholarship**

Deadline is **March 15, 2010.** The Black/Wilkins Memorial Missionary Trust Fund will award a \$500 Rich Greiner Scholarship to a student preparing for service on the mission field. Applicants will submit an application, short essay and letter of recommendation. See guidelines and application for more details and eligibility information.

### **M-E Companies, Inc. Scholarships**

Applications must be **postmarked by March 31, 2010.** Two \$1,000 Scholarships open to graduating seniors from a high school in Adams, Athens, Fairfield, Hocking, Meigs, Morgan, Muskingum, Noble, Perry, Pickaway, Scioto, Vinton or Washington. Students must have a GPA of 2.5 or better. Selection will be based upon participation in activities, financial need, acceptance into a 4-year program, and two letters of recommendation. ### **OSU Alumni Club Scholarships for Upperclassmen**

Deadline is **March 31, 2010**. Several \$500 scholarships for Muskingum County residents who have been enrolled at any campus of The Ohio State University for at least one academic year. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative college GPA of 2.5 or above.

### **Butler-Wells Scholarship**

Deadline is **April 1, 2010**. Scholarship awards range from \$250 to \$2,500. Criteria include 2.0 GPA; residency in Ohio, Pennsylvania, Indiana, or Illinois with preference for residents of Piqua, Ohio; Cincinnati, Ohio; or Miami County, Ohio. Applicants must demonstrate financial need related to cost of proposed education and commitment to giving back to the community.

### **The Muskingum County Democrat Club Scholarship**

All application materials must be received **by 5:00pm on April 1st, 2010**. An \$500 scholarship will be awarded to a Muskingum County High School college bound senior that is planning a career in the public arena. Applicant must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher (on a 4.0 scale). Applicants will submit an application, a statement of career goals and a 500-750 word essay.

### **Muskingum County Farm Bureau Scholarship Award**

Deadline is **April 15, 2010**. Scholarship will be between \$250 and \$2000 and the applicant or parents/guardian must be and have been a member of the Muskingum County Farm Bureau in good standing for at least the past three years. The applicant must attend or have attended a Muskingum County High School or if home schooled, reside in Muskingum County. For more details, download the guidelines and application.

### **Delta Kappa Gamma Muskingum County Scholarship**

Deadline is **June 30th, 2010**. \$500 grant to a resident of Muskingum County who has graduated from a Muskingum County High School preparing to teach and who is entering the final year of college, ready to student teach. The criteria used to select the recipient will include a strong interest in teaching, recommendations and scholarship.

### **Scholarship Central offers help with the FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid):**

You must complete and submit a **Free Application for Federal Student Aid** (FAFSA) to apply for federal student aid and to apply for most state and college aid. Applying online with **FAFSA on the Web** at [www.fafsa.gov](http://www.fafsa.gov) is the fastest and most efficient way to file your FAFSA. Some college FAFSA deadlines may be as early as February 1, 2010, so you should know the FAFSA deadlines for each college to which you have applied. Be sure to submit your FAFSA data to all of those colleges by indicating their federal codes in the appropriate section of the FAFSA document. Sign your FAFSA with a Federal Student Aid Personal Identification Number (PIN). If you do not have a PIN, you can apply for one at [www.pin.ed.gov](http://www.pin.ed.gov). Your PIN allows you to electronically sign when you submit your FAFSA. If you are providing parent information, one parent must also sign your FAFSA. To sign electronically, your parent should also apply for a PIN. You will need the following information to complete the FAFSA:

- Your Social Security Number and your parents' Social Security Numbers if you are providing parental information.
- Your driver's license number if you have one.
- Your Alien Registration Number if you are not a U.S. citizen.
- 2009 federal tax information or tax returns (including IRS W-2 information) for yourself (and spouse if you are married) and for your parents if you are providing

parental information. If you have not yet filed a 2009 income tax return, you can still submit your FAFSA but you must provide income and tax information.

- Information on savings, investments, and business and farm assets for yourself and your parents if you are providing parent information.

**WARNING!** Be wary of organizations that charge a fee to submit your FAFSA or to find you money for college. In general, the help you pay for can be obtained for free from your college access office, the colleges, or Federal Student Aid.

The Worksheet is not intended to be a duplicate of the paper FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid); you fill it out and use it as a guide when you are working with the FAFSA on the Web.
