

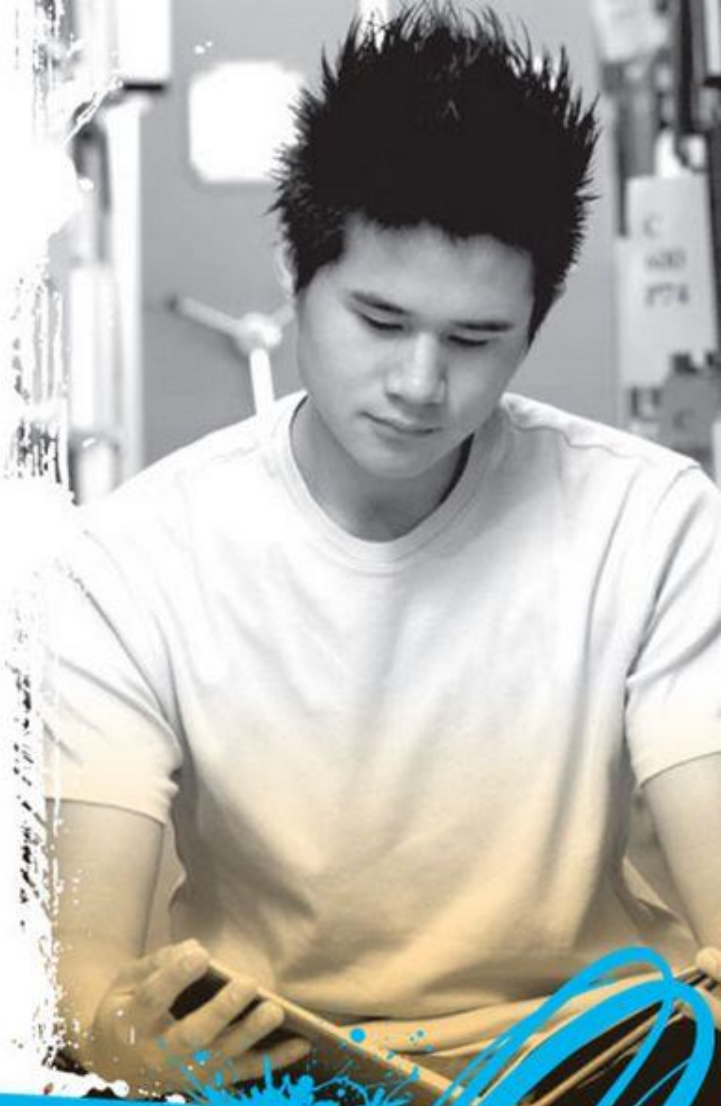

WORTH YOUR TIME





\$10,000 scholarship =
\$0 in interest
and \$0 to repay

\$10,000 federal student loan =

x 6.8% interest =
\$680/year

x 4 years of college =
\$2,720 in interest

= \$12,720 to repay

\$10,000 credit card debt =

x 19% interest =
\$1,900/year

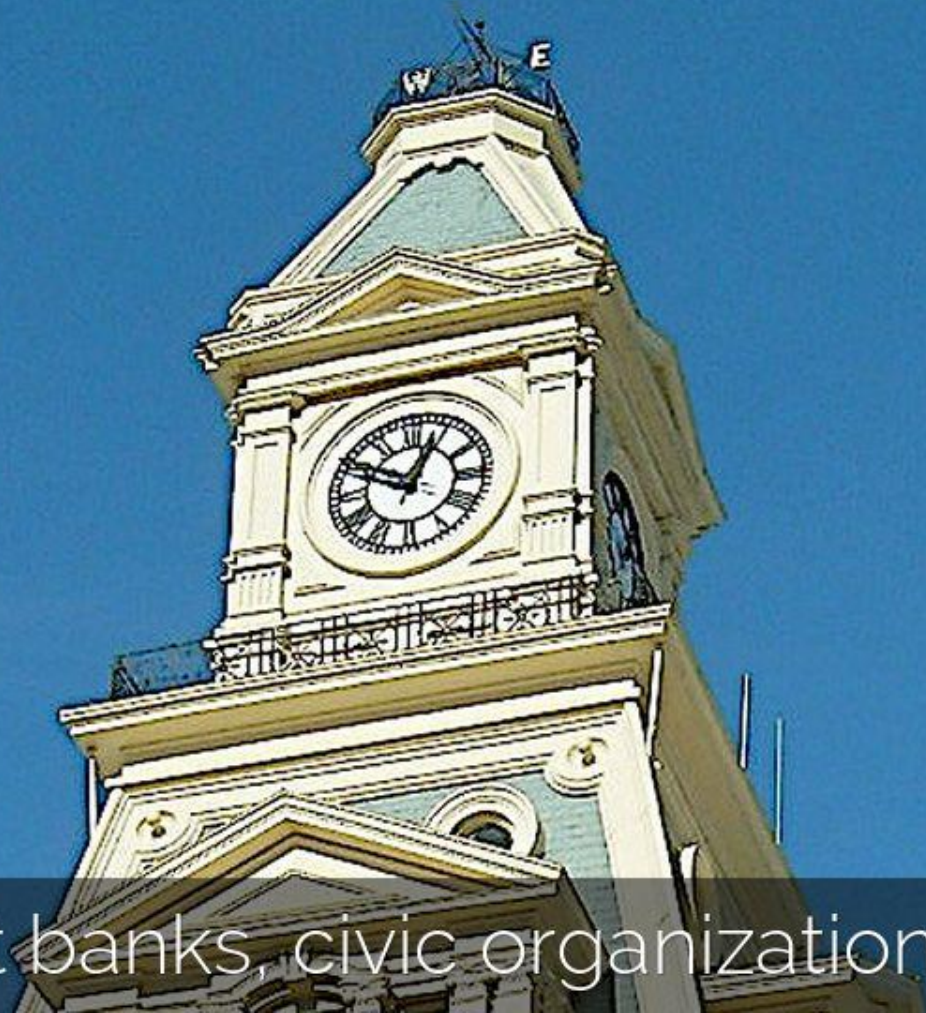
