

Are First Impressions Important?



When choosing between 2 candidates with same qualifications, 65% of employers make their decision based on what the interviewees wore!

Top 3 Personality That Can be Evaluated in 30 Seconds

- PROFESSIONALISM (86%)
- **HIGH-ENERGY (78%)**
- CONFIDENCE (61%) {confidence ranks highest on the list of skills that companies think employees are missing most}

NOTE:

 Most employers decide if they will hire a candidate within first 90 seconds of the interview

- They can teach you the skills they need you to know

WHAT'S THE BEST WAY TO FIND A GOOD JOB OPPORTUNITY

 Go hang out with people who do the work you want to do -- people who are very good at

it.



WHAT'S THE BEST WAY TO GET A JOB INTERVIEW

- Be referred by someone the manager trusts.
- Between 40 and 70 PERCENT of jobs are filled that way.
- There is nothing more powerful than a respected peer putting their good name on the line to recommend you. That's why it takes forever to get a response when you apply "blind" to a job posting.

WHAT'S THE BEST WAY TO DO WELL IN AN INTERVIEW

- Walk into every interview with your hand outstretched for a handshake, have done your homework on the interviewer and company and are dressed to fit effortlessly into the culture of the workplace
- MOST IMPORTANTLY <u>DON'T BEHAVE LIKE A JOB APPLICANT IN THE JOB INTERVIEW; BEHAVE LIKE AN EMPLOYEE</u>. While others show up asking for a job, your demonstration of how you will do the job actually helps the employer justify hiring you.
- IT TAKES BOTH CAREFUL RESEARCH AND PREPARATION TO ENTER ANY JOB WORTH HAVING THESE DAYS

NOTE: Most common question asked during an interview: "TELL ME ABOUT YOURSELF."

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU ON AN INTERVIEW

Bring in clean, professional purse, briefcase, or zippered binder. Consider bringing:

- Copies of resumes
- Copies of cover letter

Send a "Thank You" note

Bottle of water

"TO DO"

Notebook and pen to take notes

DO'S AND DON'TS FOR AN INTERVIEW

"NOT TO DO"

Arrive early	Stand out for wrong reasons – cologne, make up etc
*Smile – increases likability	DON'T CONSTANTLY USE "UMS" AND "AHS"
Bring notes – you've done your homework	DON'T LEAVE YOUR PHONE ON
Speak with enthusiasm & confidence	Don't eat or drink much before an interview
Take notes	Don't use words "ALWAYS" or "NEVER"
Bring extra copies of your resume	Don't get personal – not there to make a best friend
Answer questions with examples	One word responses = Uncommunicative
Ask for the job – "I'd love to work with you and your team"	

What NOT To Say In An Interview!



- HOW MUCH DOES THIS JOB PAY?
- MY BOSS WAS INCOMPETENT, A JERK, I HATE MY JOB.
- SAYING "I'LL HAVE YOUR JOB" WHEN ASKED WHERE YOU SEE YOURSELF FIVE YEARS FROM NOW.
- YOU LOOK GREAT
- I'M NOT AWARE OF ANY WEAKNESSES THAT I HAVE
- MAY I WORK FROM HOME OR HOW MUCH VACATION WOULD I GET?
- I DON'T HAVE ANY QUESTIONS FOR YOU.

WORST BODY LANGUAGE MISTAKES TO MAKE IN AN INTERVIEW



■ 1. BAD POSTURE {slouching}



• 2. POOR EYE CONTACT {looks like not paying attention}

• 3. FIGETING – want them to concentrate on what you say

4. EXCESSIVE NODDING {look like a bobble head doll)} a couple times more than enough

- 5. <u>CROSSED ARMS</u> {defensiveness and resistance} arms open by sides show more approachable
- 6. <u>STARING</u> good to have eye contact but occasionally look elsewhere {down right creepy if you just stare at them}



100 individuals start even at age 21 – All want to be successful.

Any idea what will happens to them by age 65?

- 1 will become rich
- 4 will become financially independent
- 5 will still be working
- 36 will be just making ends meet
- 54 will be broke!

FACT: If someone is working toward a predetermined goal & plans where he or she is going, their odds of success VERY high.

If they are not working toward a goal and have no plan, their odds of success are VERY low.



Think of ship leaving a harbor – complete voyage mapped out and how long it will take – 999 out of 1000 times it will get there.

Exact same ship – no captain at the helm – start engines and let it go – will sink or end up shipwrecked – because it has no destination or guidance.
