

AUCTION RULES

1. Live auction items may be previewed in the designated area beginning at 4:30 p. m. Please feel free to examine the items and note any restrictions or limitations E.g. size, etc.
2. The live auction will begin at 6:30 p.m. and will continue without intermission until all items have been auctioned.
3. To participate in bidding, use your assigned bid paddle. Raise it high so that it is plainly visible by the auctioneer or one of the spotters. Excited participation is highly recommended.
4. Successful bidders will be presented their items along with a card confirming the bid number and purchase price. We ask that you confirm this information by initialing the card before it is taken to the recorder.
5. Payment for items purchased must be made in full to the cashier during or immediately following the auction. The Power of the Purse Auction gladly accepts all types of credit cards, cash or your personal check made payable to the MCCF Power of the Purse.
6. In the Event of any dispute between bidders, the auctioneer shall have the sole and final discretion to determine the successful bidder or to re-offer the item in dispute.
7. The Power of the Purse Committee reserves the right to add or withdraw items, without notice to or from the auction.
8. All sales are final.
9. Each bidder agrees to hold harmless from any liability arising indirectly from the Power of the Purse Auction, its organizers, sponsors, volunteers, auctioneers or employees.
10. The value listed is an estimate or fair market value. The amount you pay above this fair market value estimate is normally tax deductible as a charitable contribution.
