- C. Applicant must enroll as a part-time or full-time student in 2024 at an accredited school to continue their education (such as, but not limited to, a college, university, community college, trade school, vocational school, art, music, theater, or fashion schools, and etc.).
- D. If awarded a scholarship, applicant agrees to exclusively use the scholarship to pay for expenses directly related to their continued 2024 / 2025 educational expenses (such as tuition, room, meals, books, fees, travel to / from home, and etc.).
- E. By completing, signing, and submitting Page 2 of 2 of this document, the applicant and applicant's parent / guardian agree to:
  - 1. Accurately provide and unconditionally release all requested information to the Dantonio Memorial Scholarships.
  - 2. Permit the applicant's name, picture, and other relevant personal information be publicly released by the Dantonio Memorial Scholarships.
