To be eligible, applicants must:

Maintain a minimum GPA of 3.0., reside in Muskingum County, be a graduating high school senior, plan to pursue a degree in a "helping profession" (such as teaching, nursing, social work, law enforcement, firefighting, or childcare), attend any type of accredited higher education institution.

Priority will be given to students from Franklin Local School District, with a special preference for those who attended Roseville Elementary School.
