Residence: Applicants must reside within Muskingum County.

Need for Economic Assistance: Must demonstrate financial need as defined by Trustee; must submit FAFSA EFC document.

Full time status: Must maintain full-time enrollment (as defined by the college)

College or University: Scholarships are available for any college or university within a traditional four year program, unless specified by a program that is longer.

Transcripts: Most recent transcript must be submitted with scholarship application.

Recommendations: Applicant must display ambition, character and leadership skills. Please provide letters of recommendation from two people who are not related to you.

Awards: Final selection of recipients and disbursement of scholarship will be made by Huntington National Bank. This is not a renewable scholarship, you must reapply each year. An award in past years is not a guarantee of an award in future years. Award amounts will be based on funds available in the current year.
